



Ask & Answer[®] Wh Bingo



**Answer the Questions for Five in a Row—
That's How You Play "Wh" Bingo!
2-6 Players • Ages 3 and up!**

Contents:

- 36 bingo playing surfaces (18 bingo boards printed front and back). Six different themes: Who?, What?, When?, Where?, Why?, and Combo!
- 144 question cards in tray.
- Bingo chips (assorted colors).

Object of the game:

Be the first player to get five chips in a row across, down, or diagonally.

How to play:

1. Decide which "Wh" Questions your students need. The boards are color-coded: Who? (Red), What? (Blue), When? (Green), Where? (Purple), Why? (Magenta), and Combo! (Yellow).
2. Pass out boards and bingo chips. Players cover the Free Space with a chip.
3. The caller shuffles the question cards that match the chosen theme board and puts them facedown in a pile.
4. The caller draws one card from the pile, reads the question, and lets the players guess the answer. As a variation, the caller can just read the answer aloud and have the players make up "Wh" questions that have this answer.
5. Each player locates the matching picture on his/her bingo board and covers it with a chip.
6. The first player to cover five pictures in a row across, down, or diagonally calls out "Wh Bingo"! This person is the winner.

Variations:

- Use question cards without the boards to reinforce questioning skills.
- Have the students place their bingo boards on the floor. Students take turns tossing bingo chips onto target boards. Students ask a question for each picture a token lands on.



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
