



**Guess the riddles for five in a row—
That's how you play Vocab Bingo!
2-6 Players • All Ages!**

Contents:

- 48 bingo playing boards (24 bingo boards printed front and back). This gives you eight different themes: Transportation; Clothing; Around the Home; Food; Occupations; Animals; Colors, Shapes & Numbers; Holiday & Seasonal!
- 192 riddle calling cards with storage bags.
- Bingo chips (assorted colors).

Object of the game:

Be the first player to get five chips in a row across, down, or diagonally.

Getting ready to play:

Separate all of the riddle calling cards. Sort them by theme and place them in the individual slots in box.

How to play:

1. Decide which theme your students need. The boards are color-coded and numbered: (1) Purple – Transportation; (2) Yellow – Clothing; (3) Teal – Around the Home; (4) Medium Blue – Food; (5) Pink – Occupations; (6) Green – Animals; (7) Royal Blue – Colors, Shapes & Numbers; (8) Red – Holiday & Seasonal.
2. Pass out boards and bingo chips. Players cover the free space with a chip.
3. The caller shuffles the calling cards that match the chosen theme board and puts them facedown in a pile.
4. The caller draws one card from the pile, reads the riddle, and lets the players guess the answer. Or the caller can just read the word aloud. It's okay to show the card picture to the players.
5. The players locate the matching picture on their bingo board and cover it with a chip.
6. The first player to cover five pictures in a row across, down, or diagonally calls out "Vocab Bingo!" This person is the winner.

Variations:

- Use the calling cards to teach classification. Have the students sort them in categories. (Example: animals, food, etc.)
- Have the students place their bingo boards on the floor. Take turns tossing bingo chips onto target cards. Use the pictures the chips land on in a story.



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
